


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Adding Gradescope to an Assignment


Once you determine the module that will house the Gradescope assignment, you can then add Gradescope. To add Gradescope:

1. In your course, navigate to **Content** and select the module that you would like to house the Gradescope assignment.


2. From the selected module, click **Existing Activities** and select Gradescope.


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3. Select whether you would like to link a **new Gradescope assignment** or an **existing Gradescope assignment**:

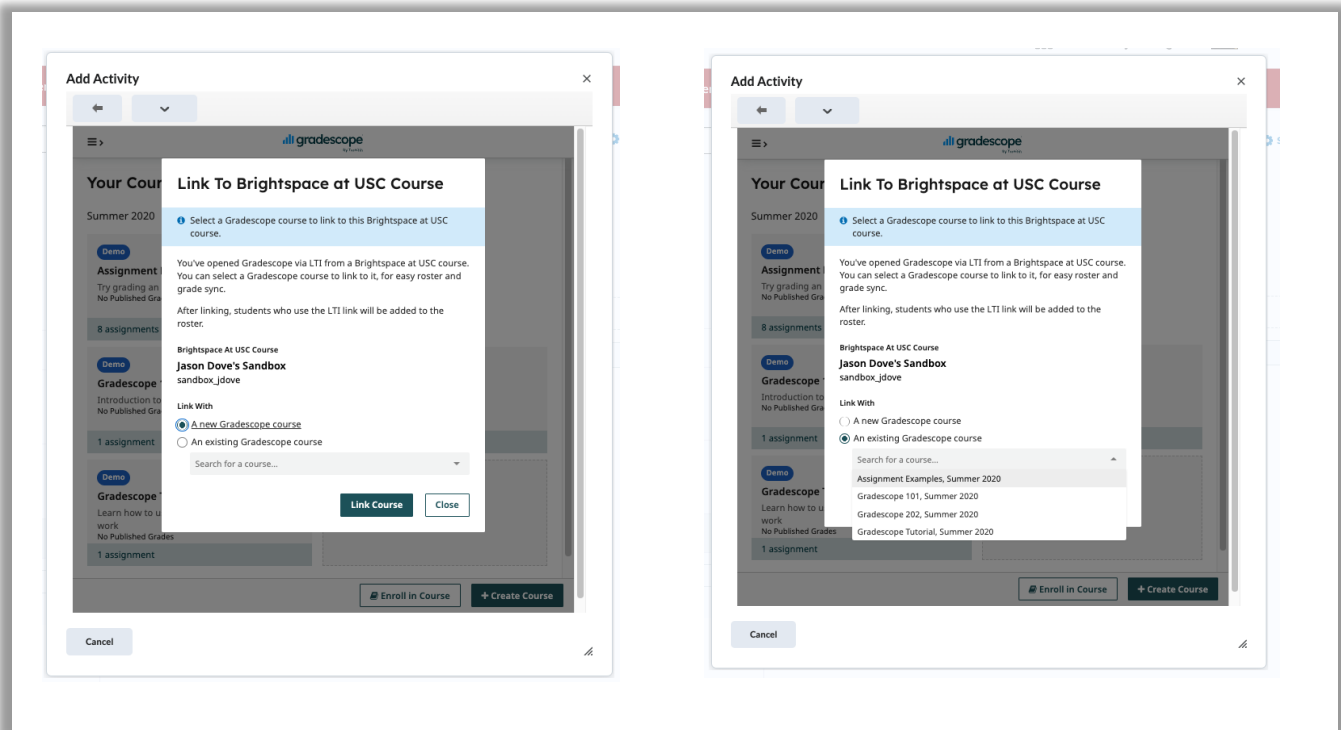
3a. If choosing an existing assignment, select the desired assignment from the drop-down menu.

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3b. Select whether you would like to link a **new Gradescope course** or an **existing Gradescope course**. Similar to linking an assignment, if you are choosing an existing course, select the desired course from the drop-down menu.




Note: You will only see the option to link a new or existing **course** to Gradescope if it is your first time selecting to link content to Gradescope.

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4. Select **Link Assignment**.

5. You have now linked to a Gradescope assignment.
