

Requirements for all Research Utilizing 0.55 Tesla MRI

You have agreed to be a research subject in a study by Dr. _____ for which a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scan is to be performed. Because the Dynamic Imaging Science Center is a research unit, not a clinical/diagnostic MRI center, the MRI scans obtained here are not meant to provide clinical/diagnostic information. The MRI scanner operating at 0.55 Tesla is an investigational device and is not approved for clinical/diagnostic use by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Most scans performed in normal human subjects are without abnormalities. However, on rare occasions an abnormality may be present; this is called an incidental finding. You are being informed that, because the MRI Center is not a clinical/diagnostic center, there are no Radiology staff members (medical doctors who are qualified to comment on MRI scans), and therefore we are unable to determine if your scan does or does not show any abnormality.

You are also being informed that all equipment at the MRI has been thoroughly disinfected before your scan but that the MRI Center cannot be held responsible for any COVID-19 infection you might develop after being scanned.
