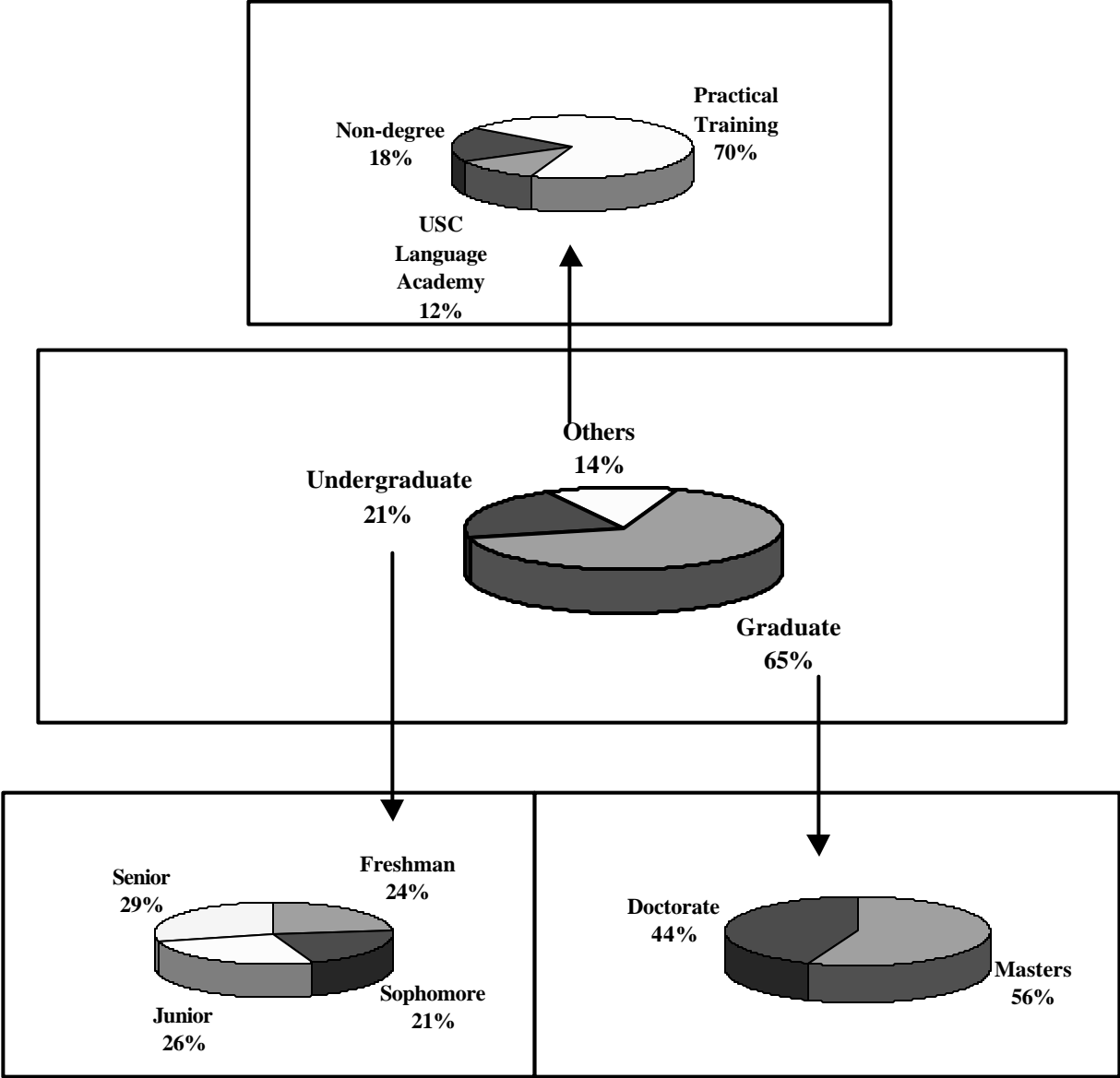

UNIVERSITY ENROLLMENT - FALL 2000**

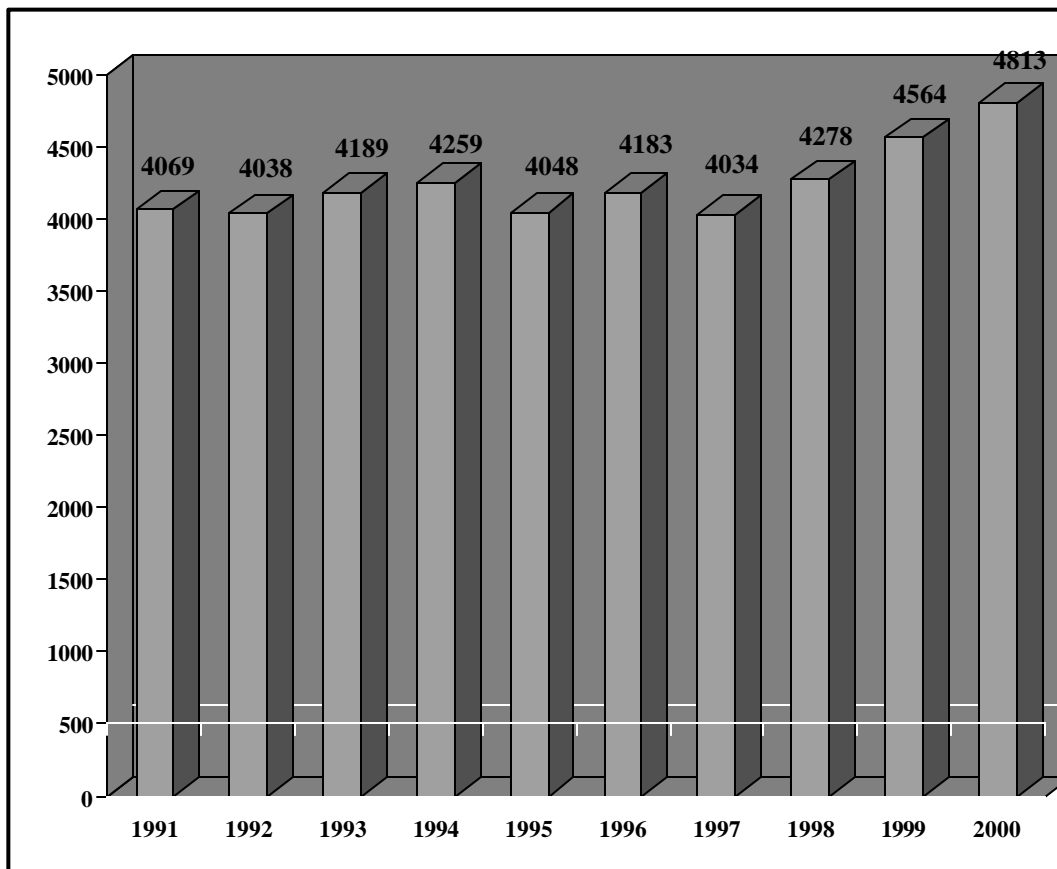

TEN YEARS OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ENROLLMENT 1991-2000*

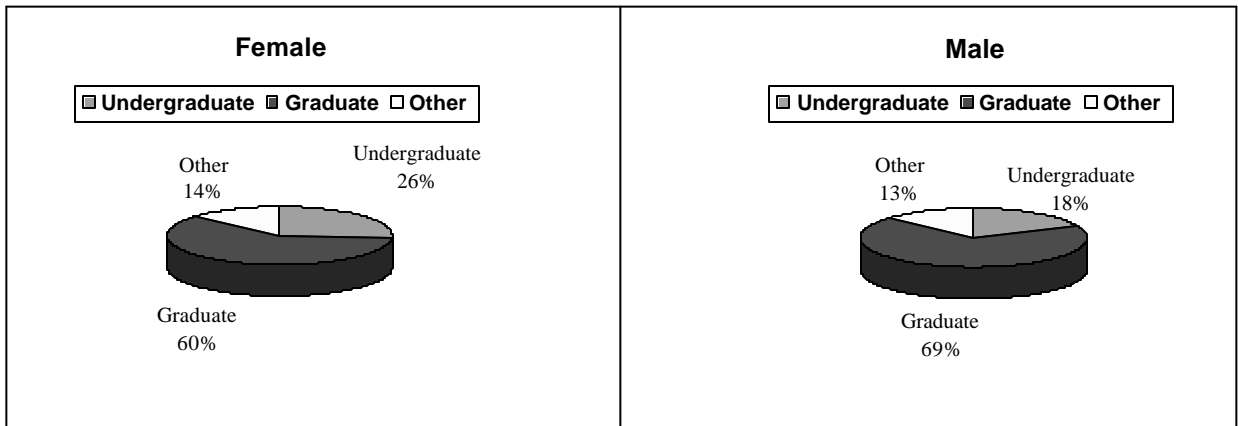
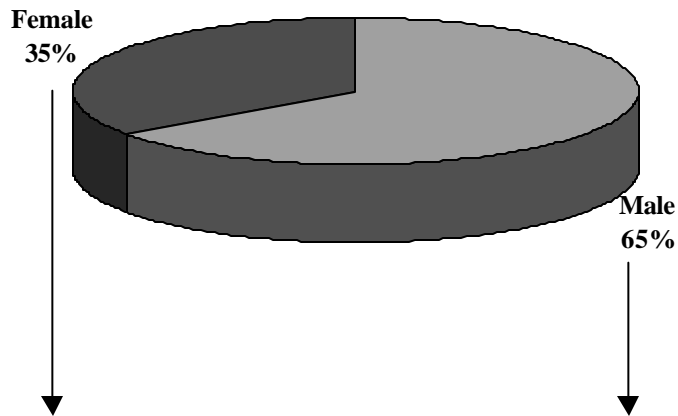

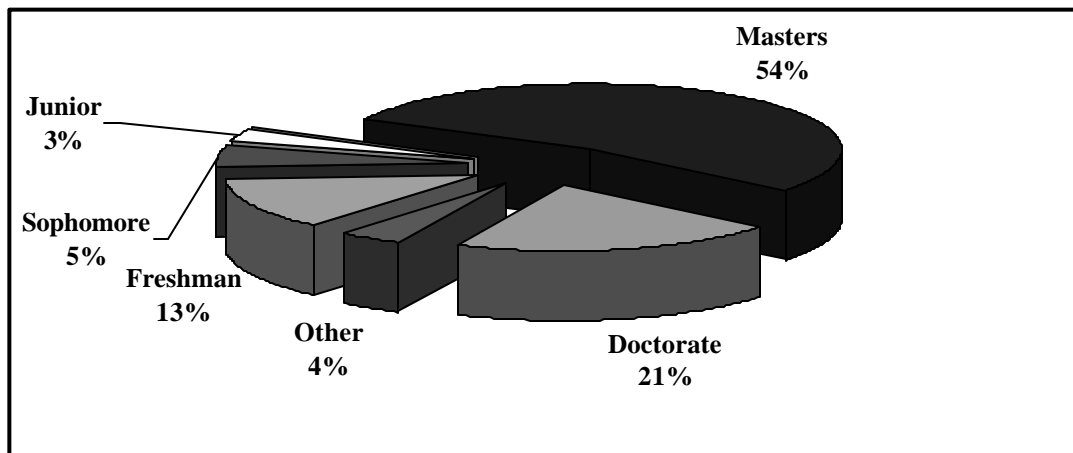

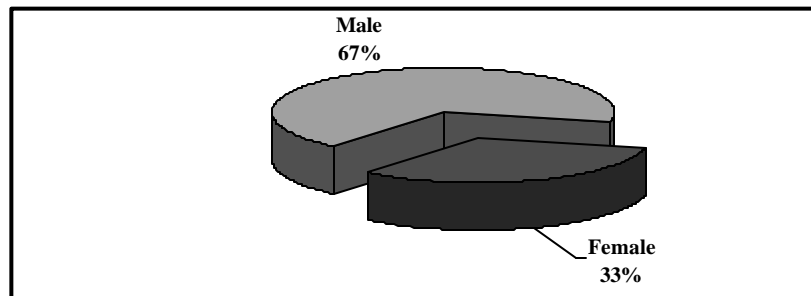

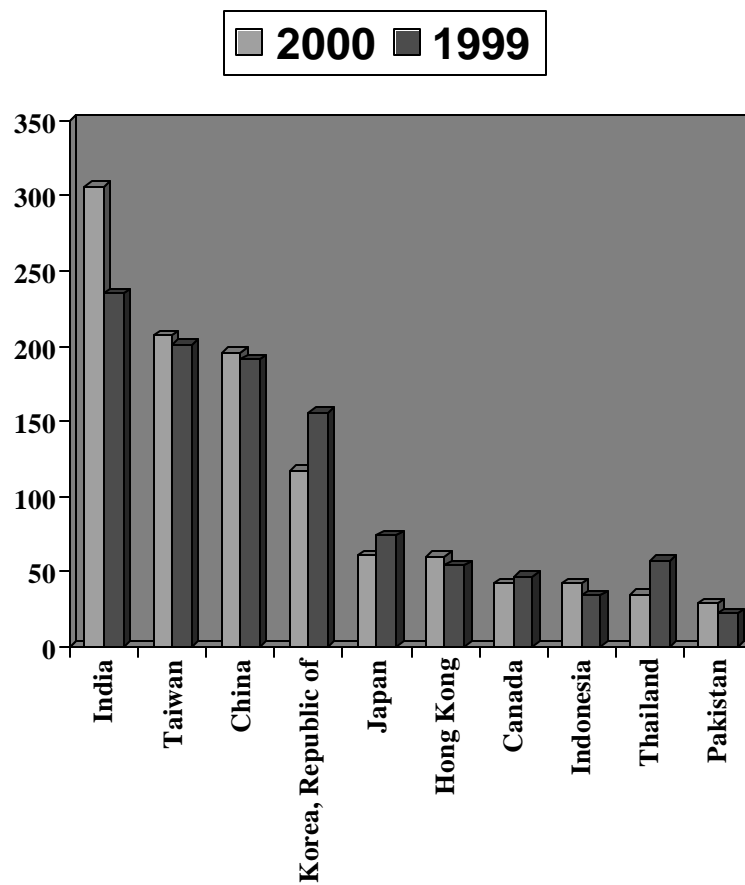
GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FALL 2000

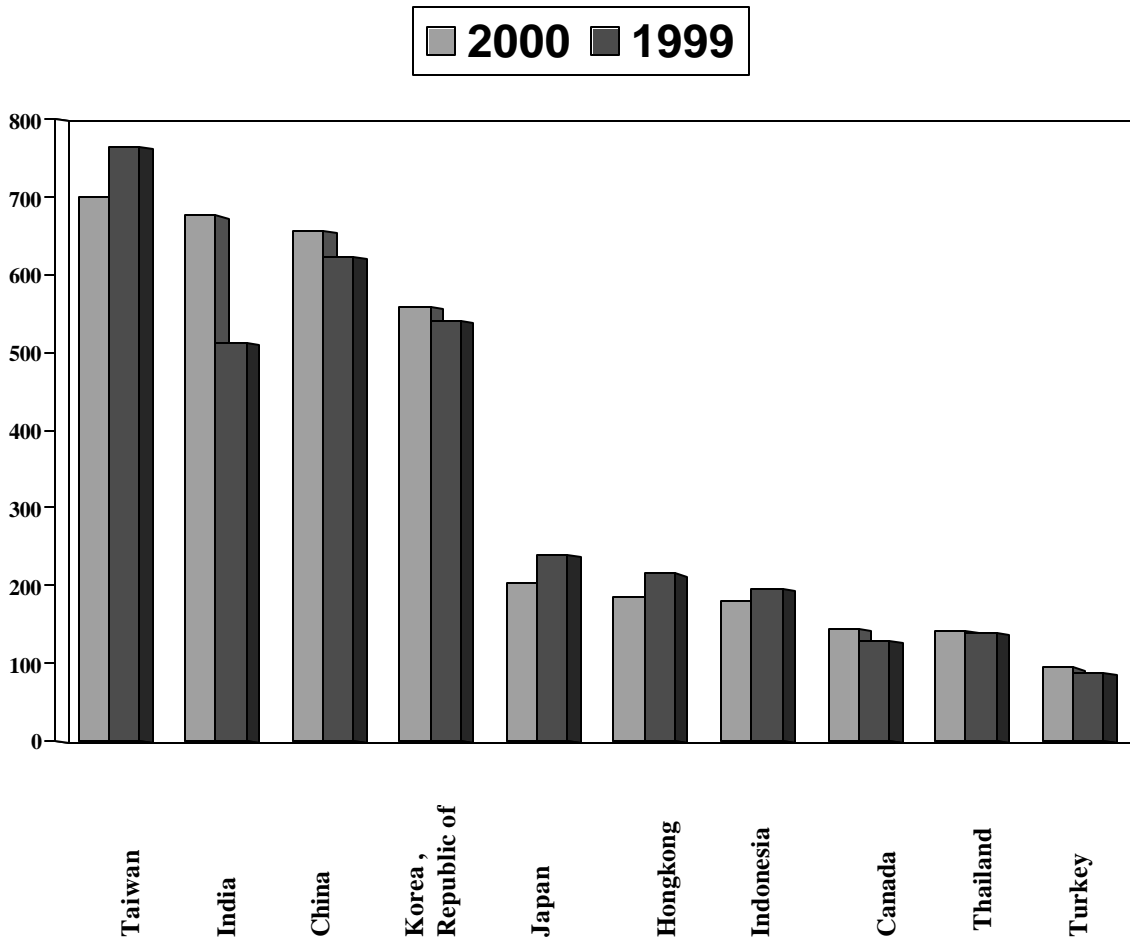

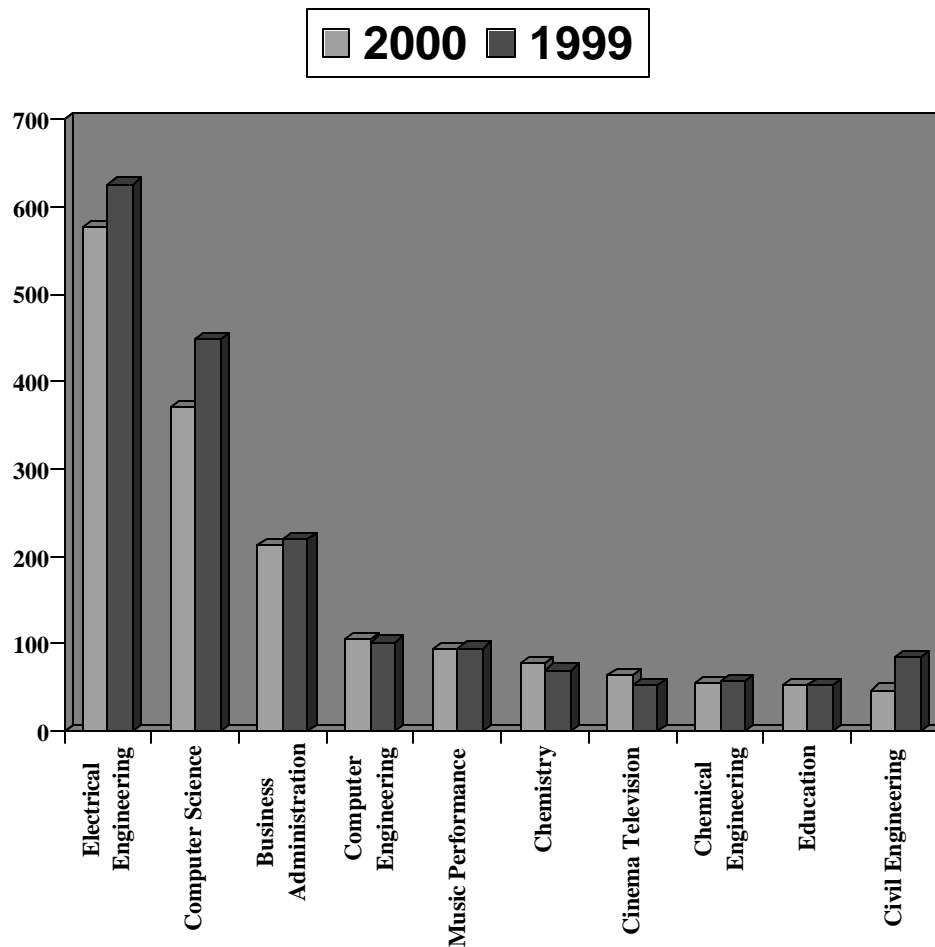
