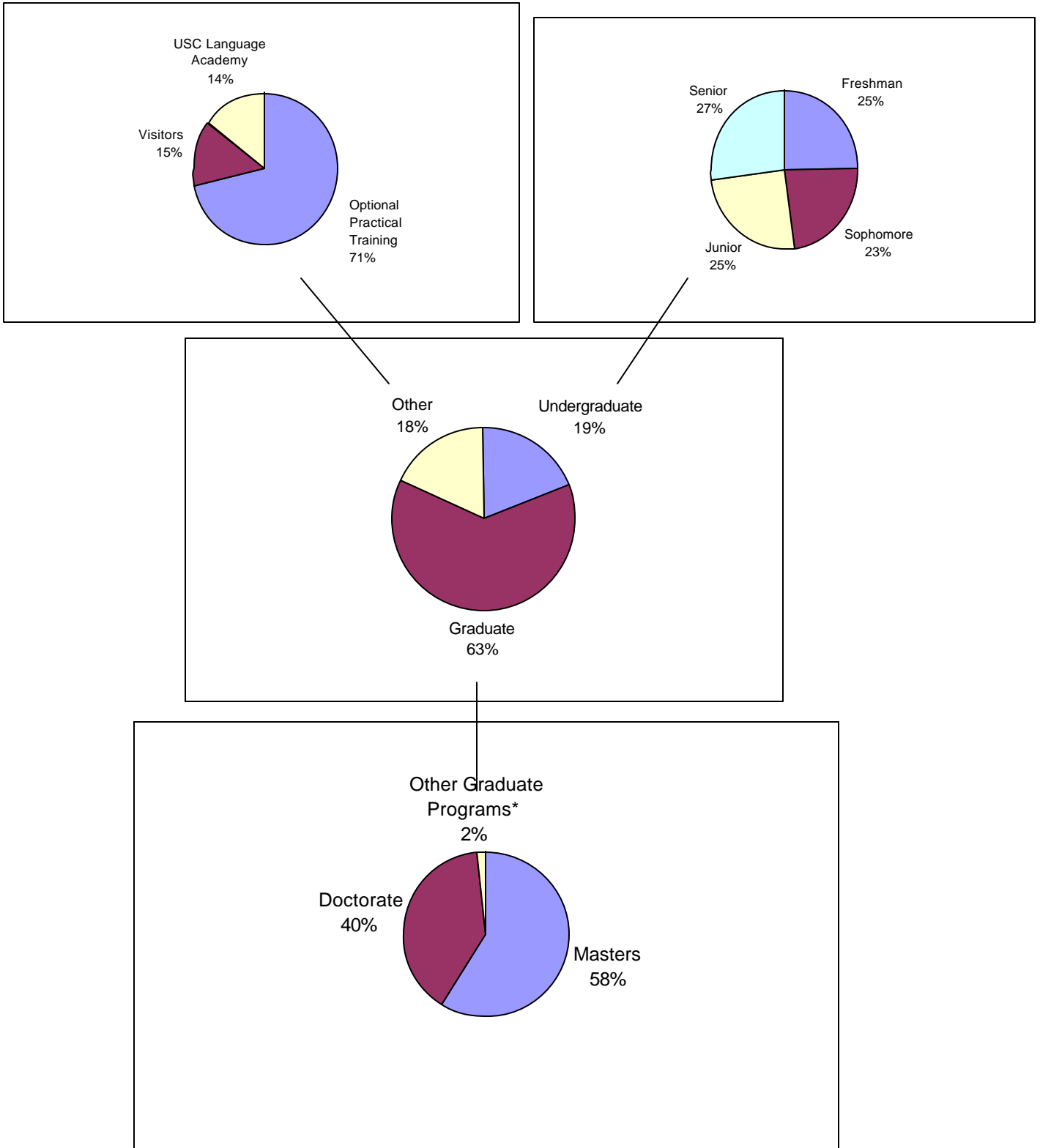

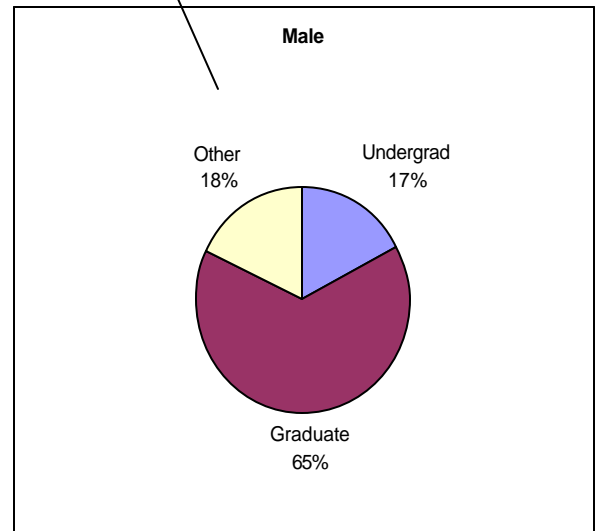
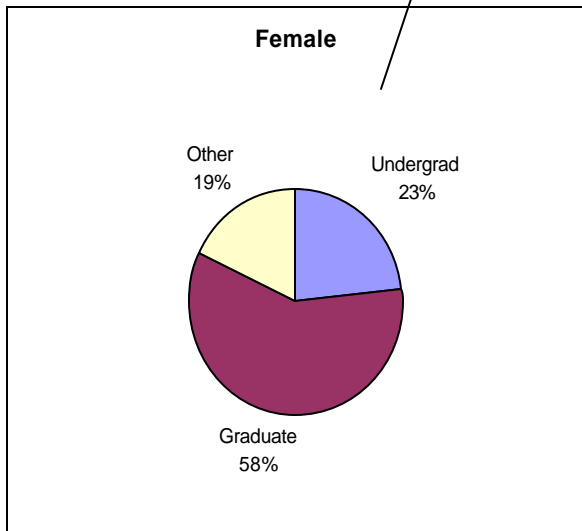
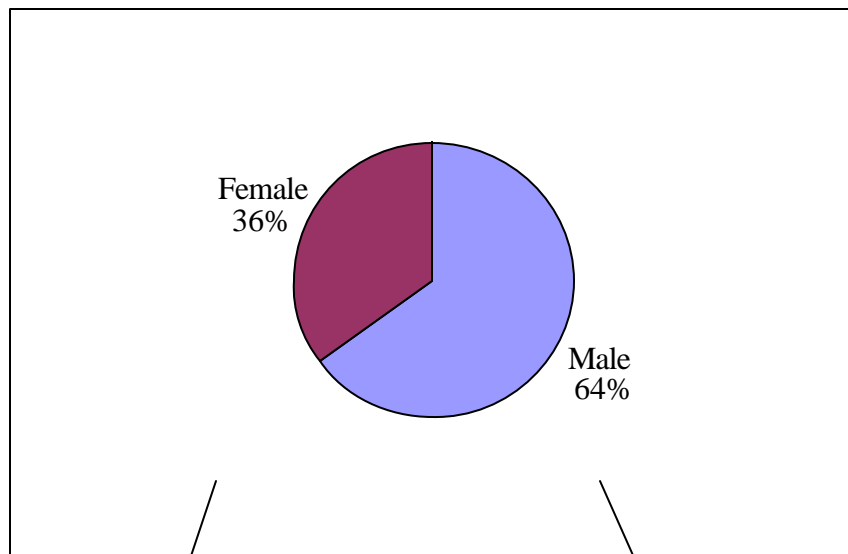
Class Distribution of Fall 2001 International Student Enrollment

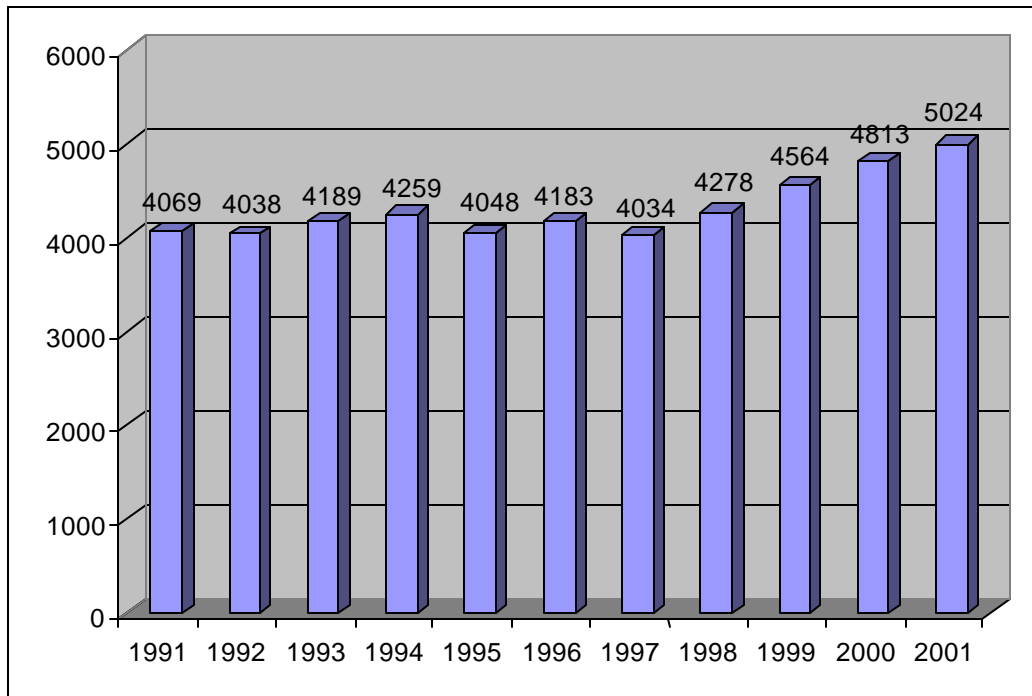


International Students as a Percent of Total University Enrollment - Fall 2001

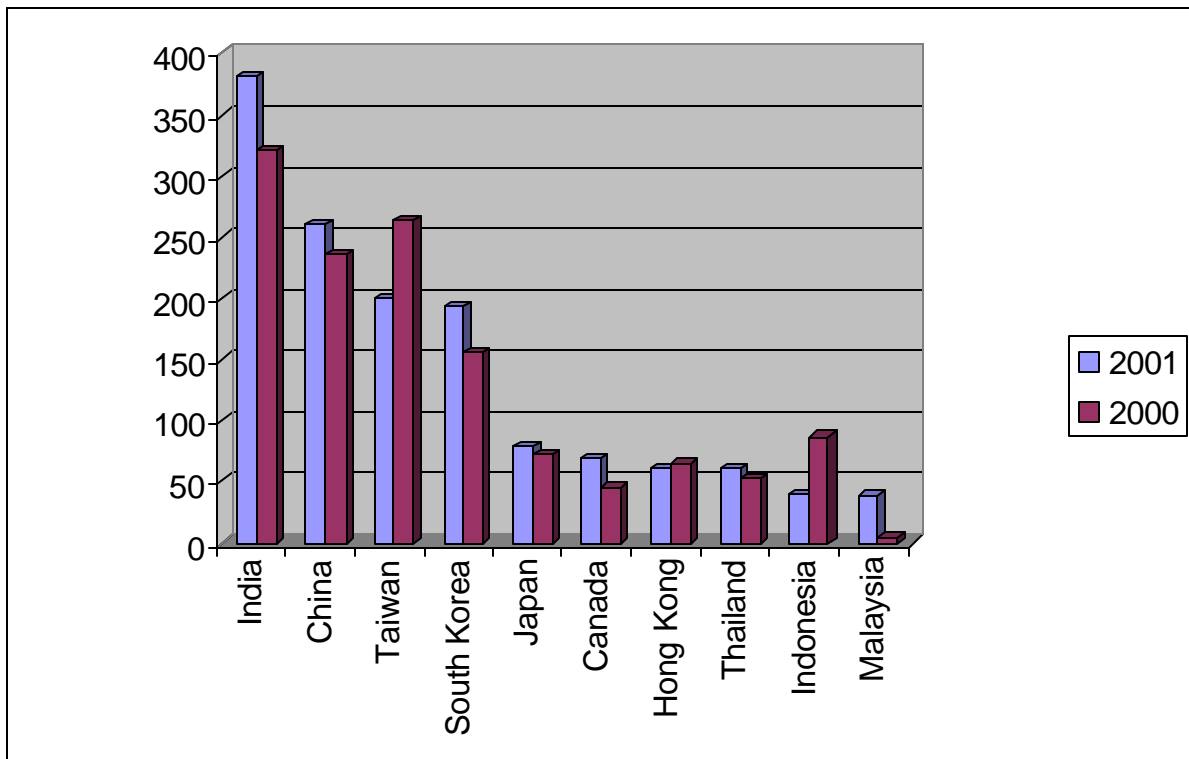

Ten Years of International Student Enrollment 1991-2001



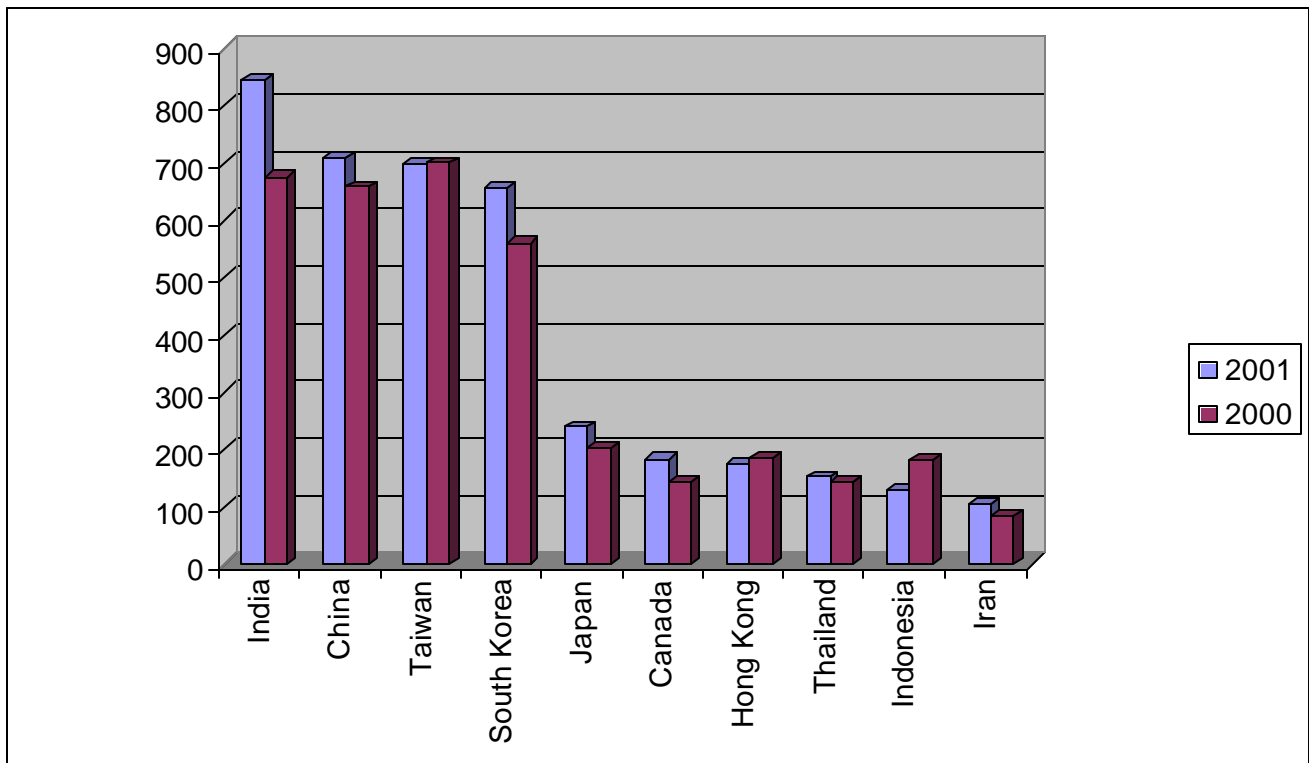
