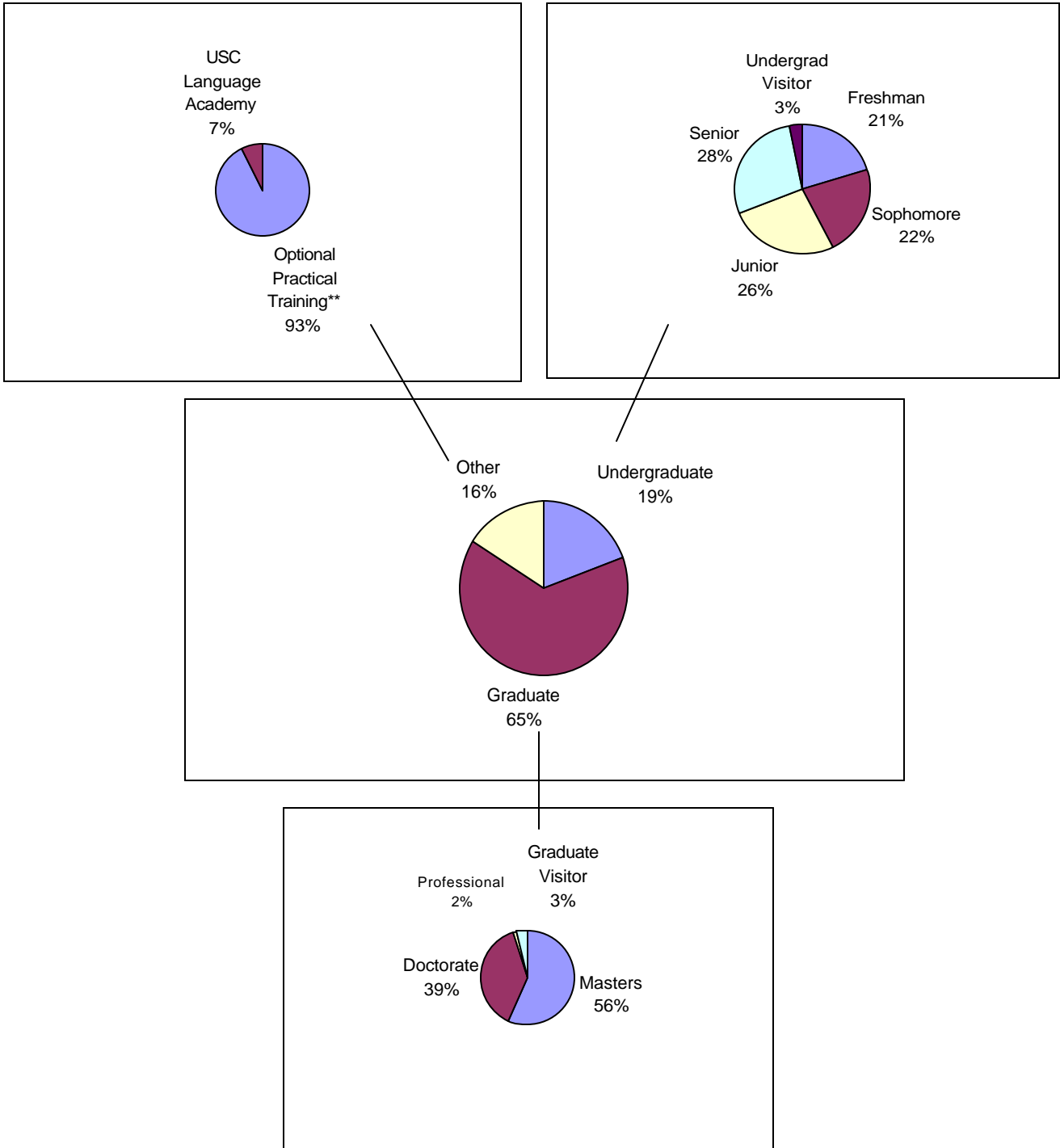

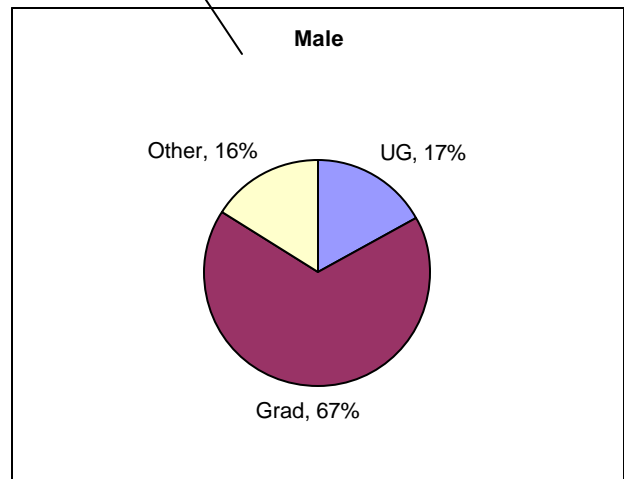
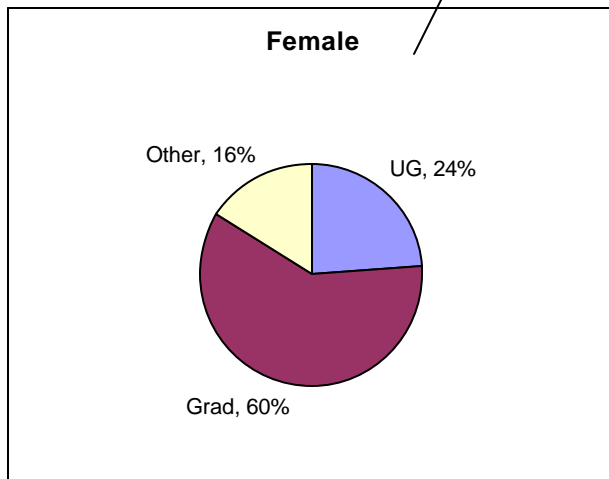
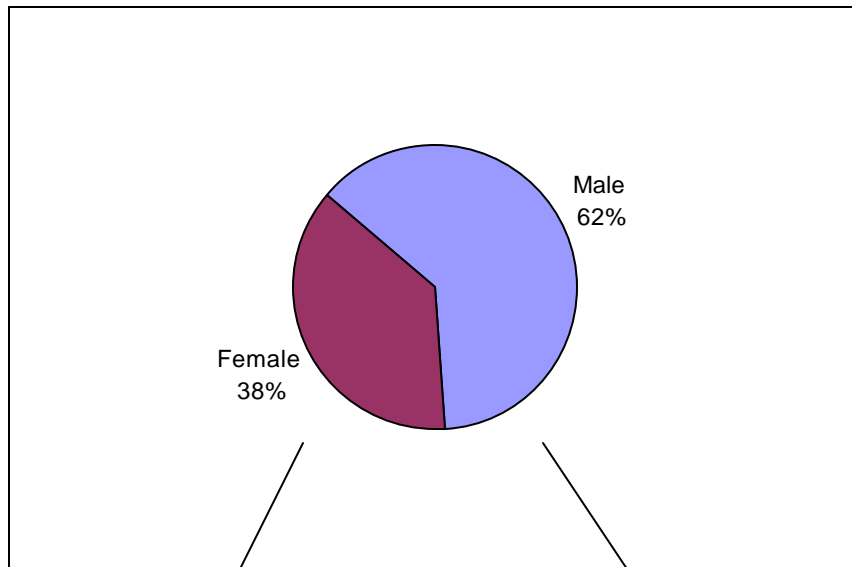

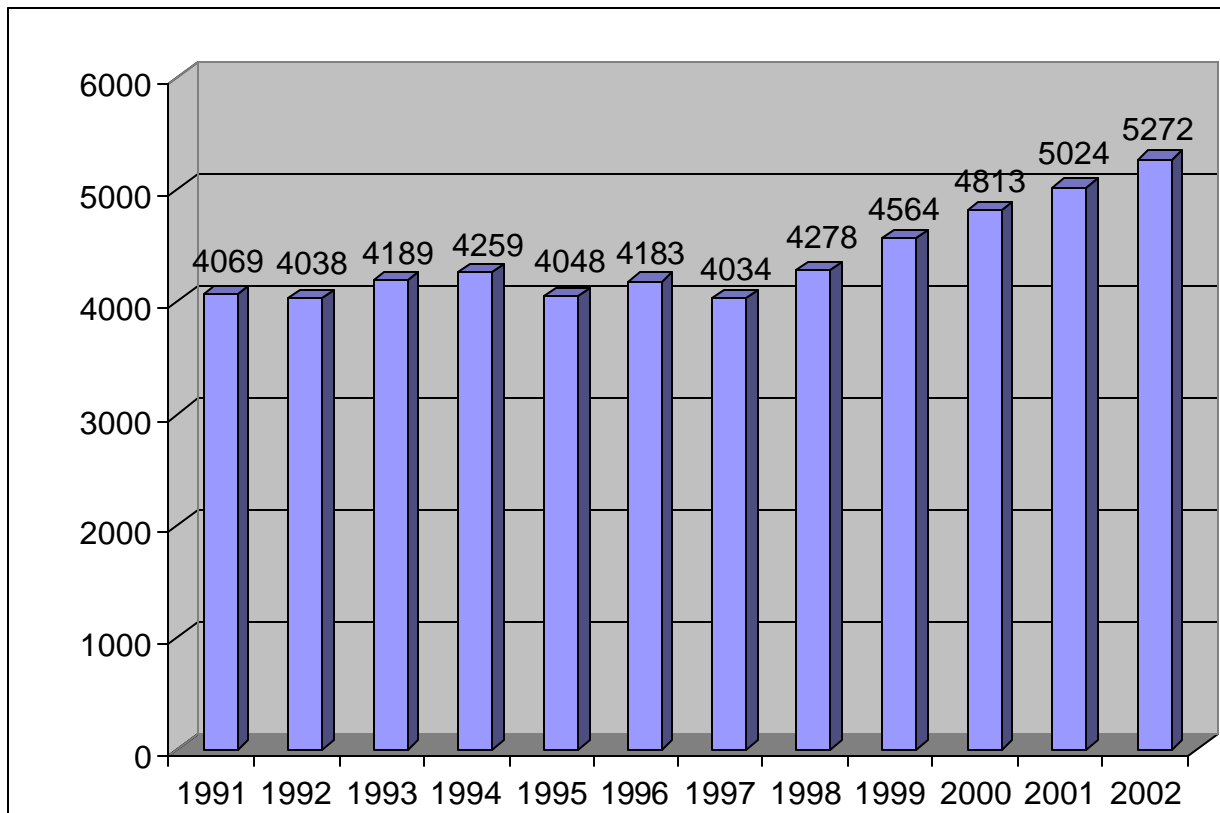

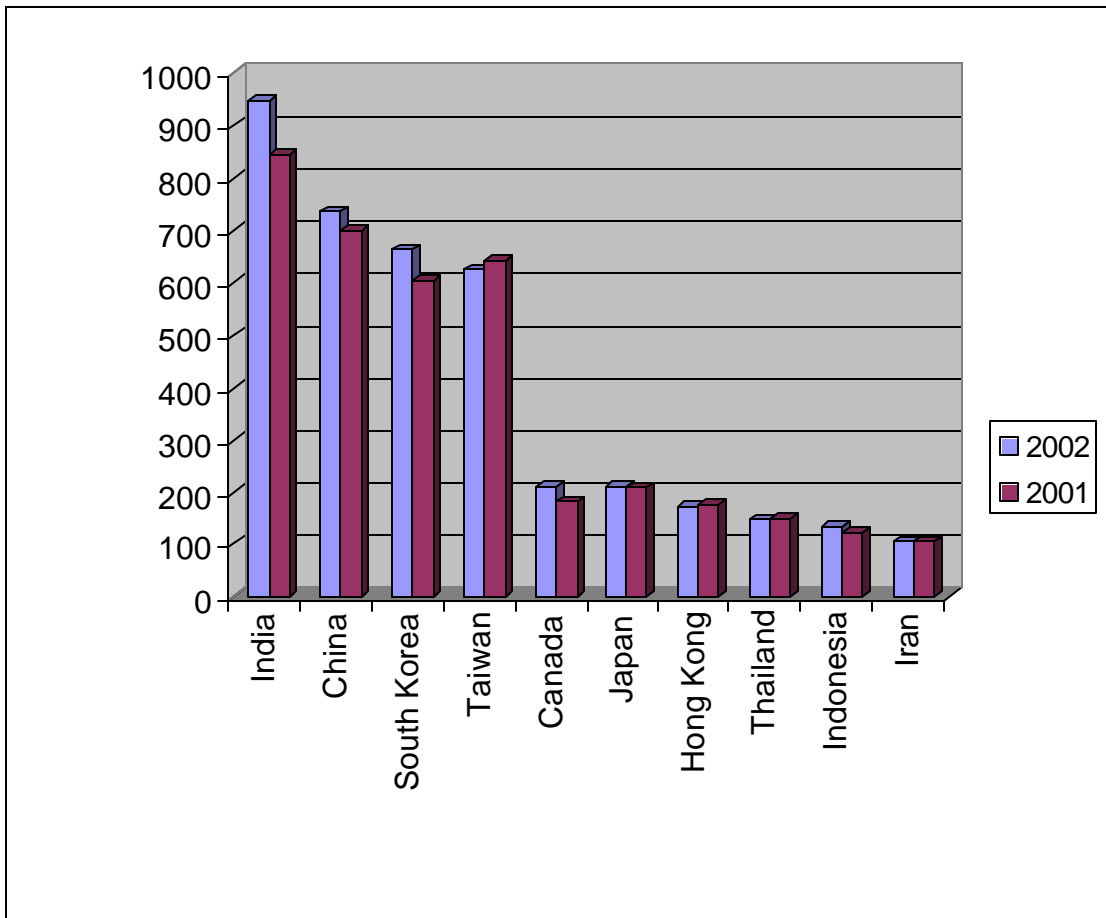
**Twelve Years of International Students Enrollment 1991-

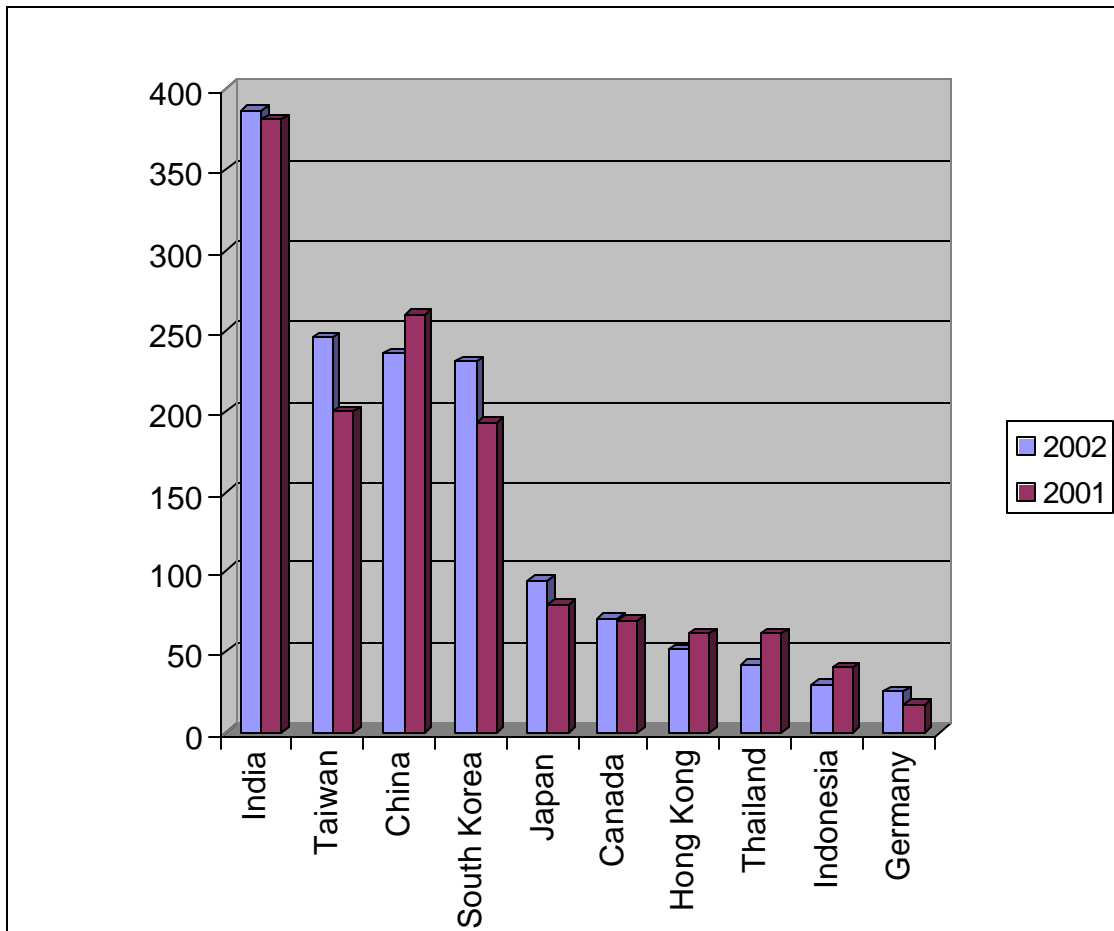

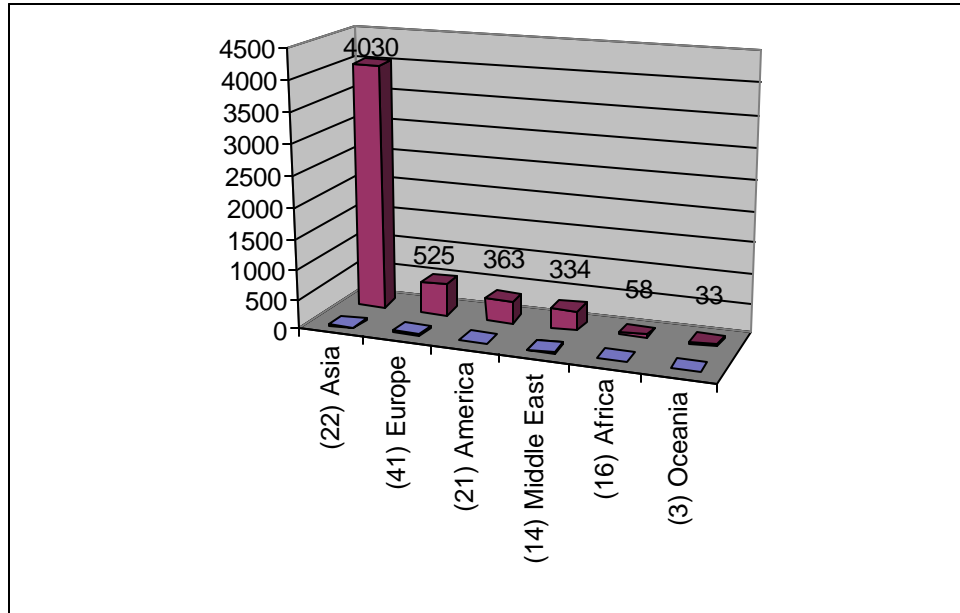

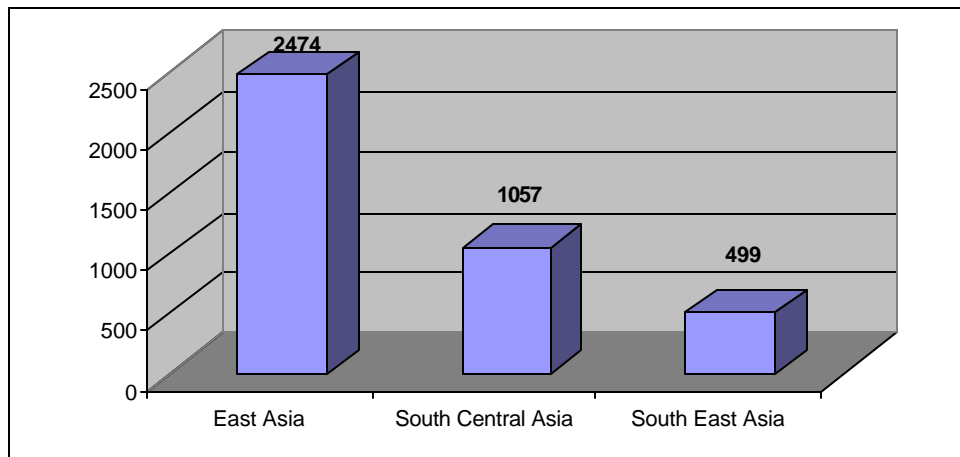
