Hawkins Mental Health Center	Psychiatry	Psychiatry: The resident workroom includes computers, a printer, and space for medical students to secure their personal belongings which is locked and accessible by a key that students are provided with on their first day of their rotation. Relaxation spaces include 2 outdoor patios next to the inpatient unit as well as a patio space near the cafeteria at MLK across the street.
Aurora Las Encinas Hospital	Psychiatry	Psychiatry: The medical students will be given the key and space in the employee cafeteria/lounge where they can relax and study. They can have access to this area anytime they are at the hospital. The students have the same access to the nursing stations where the Attending doctors also store their belongings.
California Hospital Medical Center	Obstetrics/Gynecology	OB/GYN: The L&D, antepartum call rooms are located on the 5th floor.
Children's Hospital Los Angeles (CHLA)	Neurology Pediatrics Psychiatry	Neurology: Students can complete their clinical work, study, and keep their belongings in one of three charting rooms, which are shared with other team members, as well as the Neurology resident office, which is a shared space of approximately 7 cubicles. Public space in the cafeteria and outside courtyard are available as additional study and relaxation spaces as well. Pediatrics: The resident workrooms can be used for secure storage. There are many possible study and relaxation spaces throughout the facility, including the HBO Café and patio, the meditation patio, and the Duque lobby. Psychiatry: The Psychiatry resident workroom can be used for secure storage. There are drawers available for use, desks and computers provided for studying. The workroom is within an office which requires additional badge access (which students are given during their rotation) so has an extra level of security. There are multiple relaxation spaces available for student use throughout the hospital, including but not limited to the healing garden, HBO cafe and patio, meditation patio and spiritual chapel, the Duque lobby.
Emanate	Obstetrics/Gynecology	OB/GYN: The physician lounge room is available for students to leave their belongings and use as a lounge/study area.
Huntington Memorial Hospital	Internal Medicine	IM: Students are provided space in the resident/team work room/areas. Students can also utilize common areas/cafeteria during free time.
Kaiser Permanente (Sunset)	Internal Medicine Sub I Obstetrics/Gynecology	IM Sub-I: Students are provided space in the team work room/lounge. Students can also utilize common areas/cafeteria. OB/GYN: Students may leave their personal belongings in the 4867 Sunset Blvd., 3rd locker room (locker and combo will be provided to you on your first day)
Kaweah Delta Medical Center	Neurology Psychiatry	Neurology: Students can complete their clinical work, study, and store their items in the hospital's medical library, which has individual workstations for use. This space is shared with other medical providers and is secured via badge access. There are picnic areas outside of the hospital as additional lounge/relaxation space for public use as well.

Keck Hospital	<p>Internal Medicine Sub I Neurology Obstetrics/Gynecology Psychiatry Surgery</p>	<p>IM Sub-I: Students are provided space in the resident/team work room/areas. Students can also utilize common areas/cafeteria during free time.</p> <p>Neurology: Keck Hospital has a workspace in the intensive care unit which is shared with other members of the medical team where students can complete their clinical work and a break room where students can store their belongings. Students may also utilize the resident call room for storage and studying. Additional public space is available in the cafeteria and outside courtyard spaces for studying and relaxation.</p> <p>OB/GYN: Psychiatry: Students have access to a locked resident workroom to secure any storage items. Students are welcome to use the courtyards around keck and the SOM as their relaxation spaces.</p> <p>Surgery: During the general surgery rotations, study, storage and relaxation spaces is available in the resident lounge.</p>

Available 24/7 it is a place to study, relax and connect with peers. This space includes secure storage and desks. Students are have access to the team work rooms.</p> <p>Neurology: Students have access to one of three workrooms, which are shared with other members of the neurology inpatient teams, for clinical work, study, and lounge space. The Neurology Red Team workspace has 6 computer stations, storage space, as well as a minifridge and coffee maker. The Neurology Gold Team workroom has 2 computer stations and houses a minifridge and coffee maker. The Neurology Green Team workroom has 1 computer station. Additionally, students have access to the neurology resident call room which is secured via badge access. Public space is also available in the hospital in the cafeteria, the medical library, and outside courtyard space with chairs and benches. Starting 4/1/2024 there is also a dedicated medical student lounge with computer stations, lockers, and a mini fridge.</p>

		<p>OB/GYN: The medical student lounge is located at Room #C2C101, on the 2nd floor in the C building. This room is a student lounge that may be used for resting on a night call. (This is not assigned to OBGYN and can be accessed by all medical students.) There is a resident call room/lounge on 3rd floor IPT that can act as secure storage room for medical students, as well as lounge/study/rest space.</p> <p>Pediatrics: The resident workroom can be used for secure storage and on-site study and relaxation space.</p> <p>Psychiatry: Students have access to the resident workroom which can be locked. The medical student lounge space is located on the 1st floor of IPT and includes lockers and desks with computers. Additional spaces are available for students rotating through the psychiatric ER and outpatient psychiatry clinic.</p> <p>Surgery: A dedicated call room is available to students during ACS overnight call for study, storage, and sleep. During the general surgery rotations, study, storage and relaxation spaces is available in the resident lounge.</p> <p>Additionally: The medical student call room in LA General (LAG) is located in C5C105 (5C Unit) and it is furnished with recliners, mobile desks, mobile device chargers, lockers, and a mini fridge to store your food items. Student Affairs will be providing snacks and hygiene items for the call room on a rotation basis. When entering the room, please swipe your badge first and use caution when pulling down on the door handle.</p>
Long Beach Memorial Hospital	Obstetrics/Gynecology	OB/GYN: Medical students can utilize the 2 bunk beds, computer, and desks in the Doctor Lounge.
Rancho Los Amigos	Neurology	Neurology: Students utilize a shared and secured workroom with other members of the neurology team with computers for clinical work, studying, and storage of personal belongings. Public space in the cafeteria and outdoor seating area outside of the hospital is also available as additional lounge and relaxation areas.
Santa Barbara Cottage Hospital	Internal Medicine Psychiatry	<p>IM: Students are provided space in the resident/team work room/areas. Students can also utilize common areas/cafeteria during free time.</p> <p>Psychiatry: Medical Students have a secure (keyed) private office on the 5 Pueblo unit across from the 5 Bath inpatient psychiatry unit. They have access to a desk, computer, and phone there. They can use this space for storage. The students also use the Santa Barbara Cottage Hospital library on the second floor of the same building, which has reading areas, desks, and computer stations. It's a beautifully furnished space that is very quiet and relaxing. Also the hospital has outdoor patios and gardens on the first floor where students like to have lunch, meet with their attending, or visit for a quiet, relaxing outdoor space.</p>
