

USC COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

USC students, faculty, and staff are required to submit proof of receipt of a COVID-19 vaccine. Students/faculty/staff can request an exemption if they cannot receive the vaccine because of a sincerely held religious belief, practice, or observance.
